The National Biosafety Authority (NBA) is a State Corporation established under the provisions of the Biosafety Act No. 2 of 2009 to exercise supervision and control over the development, transfer, handling and use of Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs) with a view to ensuring safety to human and animal health as well as the provision of adequate level of protection to the environment.

The Authority intends to register eligible technical biosafety experts, both firms and individuals to be placed in our Pool of Biosafety Experts for a period of two (2) years and who may from time to time be appointed to provide expert advice on biotechnology and biosafety related assignments.

The following must be submitted together with the Registration documents for the applicants to be registered and included in the list of Registered Biosafety Experts for a period of two (2) years:

SECTION III: - INFORMATION TO TENDERERS (ITT)

3.1 Introduction

- 3.1.1 NBA will register and enlist prospective Tenderers for the provision of Biosafety expert reviews on GMO Applications from among those who will have submitted their Registration documents in accordance with the Registration requirements to undertake the assignments described herein for two (2) years.
- 3.1.2 The Registration of Biosafety expert reviewers does not constitute a retainer.
- 3.1.3 The Registration Tender document and the Tenderers response thereof shall be the basis for Registration. Tenderers must familiarize themselves with the requirements described in this document including all attachments and take them into account while preparing their response.
- 3.1.4 Tenderers will be informed in writing of the results of their application.
- 3.1.5 Tenderers will meet all costs associated with preparation and submission of their applications.
- 3.1.6 **National Biosafety Authority** Act require that Tenderers observe the highest standards of ethics and professionalism in the procurement process and execution of Service Level Agreements. In pursuance of this Act, NBA:
 - a. Defines, for the purpose of this provision, the terms set forth below:
 - i. "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of an officer of the Procurement Entity/Purchaser/Employer in the Registration process; and
- ii. "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence the Registration process to the detriment of the Purchaser/Employer, and includes collusive practices among Tenderers (prior to or after submission of Tenders) designed to establish prices at artificial, non-competitive levels and to deprive the Procurement Entity of the benefits of free and open competition.
 - b. Will reject a Tender for Registration if it determined that a Tenderer has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent activities in competing for the tender in question;
 - c. Will declare a Tenderer ineligible, for Registration if at any time it determines that Tenderer has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a similar tender; and
 - d. Will have the right to inspect the business premises of the Tenderer.
 - 3.1.8 Tenderers shall furnish information as described in the Registration tender document.
 - 3.1.9 Tenderers shall be aware of the provisions on fraud and corruption stated in herein after.

3.2 Scope of Services

The scope of services for the identified biosafety experts (firms or individuals) will include among other duties; review of GMO Applications to give scientific opinions before decisions are made by the Authority and undertake any biosafety related duties as may be assigned by NBA.

3.3. Terms of Reference (TORS) for Biosafety Expert Reviewers (Firms or Individual Experts)

Biosafety Experts may be engaged by the Authority to undertake different assignments depending on their academic qualifications and experiences. The reviews will include risk assessment, including risk management measures for all GMO Applications, and socio-economic impact assessment for GMO applications being considered for commercial approval.

(a) Terms of Reference (TORs) for Biosafety Expert Reviewers on Risk Assessment and Risk Management of Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs)

Biosafety experts with Biological Sciences background with at least a Master's degree in relevant fields such as; Biological Sciences, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Environmental Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Veterinary Sciences, Applied Sciences, or other equivalent fields from recognized institutions, will be engaged on need basis to undertake the following assignments;

- 1. To examine GMO application documents and undertake a scientific risk assessment, taking into account general principles for the conduct of risk assessment with special reference but not limited to information on;
 - i. Recipient or parental organism (the unmodified organism(s).
 - ii. Potential risks that may be associated with the donor organism(s) and its origin.
 - iii. Potential risks that may be associated with the genetically modified organism(s).
 - iv. The receiving environment.
 - v. The intended or potential uses of the genetically modified organism(s).
 - vi. Risk management measures proposed by the applicant with an indication of whether they are adequate.
 - vii. Any other relevant information.
 - viii. General recommendations for approval with conditions (if any), or otherwise with reasons.
- 2. Submit a review report on above parameters to the National Biosafety Authority within set timelines.
- 3. To undertake biotechnology and biosafety related consultancies, studies, surveys, advisories, and any other assignments as may be requested by the National Biosafety Authority.

b) Terms of Reference (TORs) for Biosafety Expert Reviewers on Socio-Economic Impact Assessment of Genetically Modified Organisms

Biosafety experts with Social Sciences background with at least a Master's degree in relevant fields such as; Business studies, Social Sciences or other equivalent fields from recognized institutions will be engaged on need basis to undertake the following assignments;

- 1. To examine GMO application documents and undertake an assessment taking into account general principles for the assessment of socio-economic considerations with special reference to;
 - i. Socio-economic impacts (positive or negative) that may be experienced on release of the genetically modified organisms (GMOs) into the environment or placing on the market, including but not limited to;
 - Impact of the GM technology on food security and sustainability;

- Access to the Technology by farmers, including royalties (if any);
- Expected incomes and potential benefits of the GM technology to farmers;
- Cost of GM seeds compared to other seeds/planting materials;
- Implication of commercialization of the GM technology on Trade (national, regional and international level);
- Proposed measures put in place for assurance of freedom of choice by consumers between GM and other existing technologies;
- Monitoring and Stewardship plans of the technology post commercialization.
- ii. Any other relevant information.
- iii. General recommendations for approval with conditions (if any), or otherwise with reasons.
- 2. Submit a review report on socio-economic impact assessment, to the National Biosafety Authority within set timelines.
- 3. To undertake biotechnology and biosafety related consultancies, studies, surveys, advisories, and any other assignments as may be requested by the National Biosafety Authority.

3.4 Deliverables

At the end of each assigned work, the Expert Firm or Individual Expert Reviewer will submit to the Authority;

- a) Review reports and recommendations for GMO Applications assigned to the expert(s) within set timelines;
- b) Survey, study, consultancy reports on assignments given to the experts from time to time.

3.5 Clarifications of Registration documents

Tenderers may request a clarification on the Tender Registration document up to seven (7) days before the Tender submission date. Any request for clarification must be sent in writing by postal mail or electronic mail to the NBA address nbaprocurement@biosafetykenya.go.ke or info@biosafetykenya.go.ke . NBA will respond in writing by normal postal mail or electronic mail to such requests and will send copies of the response to all Tenderers who intend to submit tenders.

3.6 Preparation of Tender Documents

- 3.6.1 Tenderers are requested to submit a Tender written in English language.
- 3.6.2 Tenderers are expected to examine the documents comprising this Request for registration in detail. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested may result in rejection of a Tender.

- 3.6.3 Tenderers are required to meet the Registration criteria stipulated hereinafter. Those who do not meet the requirements need not submit tenders. Only tenders, which fulfil these requirements, will be considered for detailed evaluation.
- 3.6.4 The Registration documents shall not include any financial proposal information.

3.7 Period of Validity

The request for Registration must remain valid for not less than one hundred and forty (140) days from the date of submission. NBA will make best effort to complete the evaluation and communicate within this period.
