The National Biosafety Authority is a State Corporation established under the Biosafety Act, 2009 with a mandate to exercise general supervision and control over the transfer, handling and use of genetically modified organisms (GMOs) with a view to ensuring safety of human and animal health as well as providing adequate protection of the environment.

The Act requires the Authority to prescribe fees for the services it offers.
